



NATIONAL PANCAKE DAY AT IHOP – February 28, 2012

Guidelines for National Pancake Day

National Pancake Day at IHOP will be Tuesday, February 28, 2012. El Jebel Temple will have 23 locations in Front Range and Grand Junction area Colorado. Brochures and posters will be delivered for this event.

It is imperative that we have Nobles present at each location during the entire day from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. IHOP will have a donation receptacle at the location. IHOP will give a free short stack of pancakes and the Noble will ask the customer to donate the cost of the pancakes to Shriners Hospitals for Children. The Nobles should greet customers as they come in and hand out the brochures and answer questions about Shriners and Shriners Hospitals for Children. You may be asked to do other interactions with the customers, so try and help out where you can. Keeping busy will make the day go by faster. This can be a membership tool as well as a fund raiser. Please, while working your shift, do not sit at the tables and drink coffee or eat a meal. If you are done with your shift and wish to eat, please remove your Fez and take it to your vehicle.

Units and Clowns are needed at as many locations as possible. Consider having the Clowns rotate among the different locations. Park one of your motorized vehicles (T-Nobles, Bees, Daraja, Motorcycles or other vehicles) in front of the location. This helps to draw attention to the IHOP that something special is going on inside the store!

We still have eight stores that need Store Captains. Shifts will be scheduled by the Store Captains. Each hour worked will be worth five points. Remember, the Nobles will be inside and not in the weather.

At the end of the event, the Store Captain should count the money with the manager on duty, give the manager a receipt for the money and turn the money into Rebecca the following morning.
