SANDBLASTER UNIFORMS

Sandblasters are urged, but not required, to wear appropriate uniform for various events.

Uniform consists of:

1. Golf shirt with logo and/or golf jacket with logo, for men and women. Wear these at golf tournaments or any other event where you are proud to be identified as a Sandblaster.
2. Forest green sport jacket or blazer. Accessorize this "dress" uniform with any Khaki or tan pants with dress or sport shirt (tie or bolo optional). Wear to monthly luncheon meetings or golf cocktail parties and banquets, especially at overnight tournaments; also appropriate at stated El Jebel meetings and Sandblaster funerals. For further details see or phone uniform chairman or any officer.

SANDBLASTER RULES OF GOLF

U.S.G.A. rules shall govern all play except as modified by local rules of the course being played and the following:

1. HANDICAPS:

- A. Only Sandblaster/Duffers handicaps are recognized for play in an event.
- B. To qualify for a handicap, members, ladies and guests must have scores in five (5) or more golfing events. (Handicaps are calculated based on 5 best scores of last 10 tournaments.)
- C. Maximum handicap is 40 for Men and 50 for Ladies.
- D. Members over 70 years old with a handicap of 36 or over may use the front tee box on all holes.

2. AWARDS:

- A. Until a Sandblaster handicap is established, a member, lady or guest may be eligible to win only the following:
 - 1. Low Gross
 - 2. Closest to the Pin
 - 3. Closest to the line
- B. A member, lady or guest may be given only ONE (1) award for each day of play.
- C. You need not be present at the event Dinner or Luncheon to receive an award.
- D. Only active regular **SANDBLASTER** Members are eligible to win event trophies.
- E. To be eligible for the Winn Bennett trophy (men's low gross average), a member must have played in 75% of the local Sandblaster tournaments during the season.

Note: The following will apply to all Sandblasters Golfing events, unless otherwise specified by the Chairman for the event:

- "GIMME PUTTS" - All putts within 16 inches are gimmes. Pick up and add one stroke to your score.
- Pick up your ball when you have achieved DOUBLE PAR ON THE HOLE. Add one stroke to the double par and use that number as your score for that hole. DO NOT CONTINUE TO PLAY THE HOLE.
- BALL OUT OF BOUNDS OR A LOST BALL: Drop a ball in the approximate location at where the ball was lost or went out of bounds. Add one penalty stroke to your score.
- PLAY READY GOLF. Keep up with the foursome ahead of you! DO NOT USE THE HONORS SYSTEM. Hit when you are ready.
- Mark your scores AFTER leaving the green,

The COURSE Marshal is responsible for maintaining the "PACE OF PLAY." Should you fall more than a hole behind, the Marshal shall be authorized to require that your group pick up and go to the next tee. Note the pick up on your score card and the handicap committee will adjust your score.

The intent of these rules is to maintain a pace of play that is consistent with the requirements of all Golf Courses thereby improving the Sandblasters reputation with the courses.
